THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION WAS ADOPTED:

IN RE: ADOPTING RECENT RETIREMENT LAW CHANGE

WHEREAS, on September 9, 1983 the Governor signed SB 701 (McCorquodale) which amends the 1937 Retirement Act Safety Membership provisions to permit certain individuals incorrectly placed in the safety membership system years ago (and subsequently moved into the miscellaneous system) to regain safety benefits; and

WHEREAS, the Bill provides that the change will not be operative unless a resolution adopted by a majority of the members of the Board of Supervisors so authorizes; and

WHEREAS, the Personnel Director recommends that this Board approve said resolution,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Stanislaus County Board of Supervisors does hereby approve Senate Bill 701 making applicable to Stanislaus County the provisions of Section 31558.3 of the Government Code.
