R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, the Board of Retirement has recommended that this Board of Supervisors, by resolution, reduce retirement age from fifty-five to fifty; and

WHEREAS, Actuaries herein have indicated that the cost of such reduction to the County would be of insignificant proportion,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that, pursuant to the provisions of Section 31672 of the Government Code, the age of retirement of any member who has completed ten (10) years of continuous service be, and hereby is, reduced from age fifty-five (55) to age fifty (50).

Upon motion by Supervisor Arakelian, seconded by Supervisor Paul, the foregoing resolution was duly passed and adopted at a regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Stanislaus, State of California, this 20th day of March, 1973, by the following called vote:
