

AN ORDINANCE MAKING SECTIONS 31681.5 AND  
 31739.3 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF THE  
 STATE OF CALIFORNIA APPLICABLE TO THE  
 COUNTY OF STANISLAUS AND THEREBY INCREAS-  
 ING THE RETIREMENT ALLOWANCES OF MEMBERS  
 OF THE RETIREMENT ASSOCIATION OF THE COUNTY  
 OF STANISLAUS WHO HAVE BEEN RETIRED FOR  
 SERVICE OR DISABILITY

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Stanislaus,  
 State of California, do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. The Board of Supervisors of the County of  
 Stanislaus, State of California, does hereby make the provisions  
 of Section 31681.5 of the Government Code of the State of  
 California, and Section 31739.3 of the Government Code of the  
 State of California applicable in the County of Stanislaus, in  
 which the County Employees Retirement Law of 1937, being Chapter  
 3 of Part 3 of Division 4 of Title 3 of the Government Code of  
 the State of California, is now in full force and effect.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in  
 force thirty (30) days from and after the date of its passage,  
 and before the expiration of fifteen (15) days after its passage  
 it shall be published once with the names of the members  
 voting for and against the same in THE MODESTO BEE, a newspaper  
 published in said County of Stanislaus, State of California.

Upon motion of Supervisor Ruggieri, seconded by Super-  
 visor Domecq, the foregoing ordinance was passed and  
 adopted at a regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors of  
 Stanislaus County, California, this 11th day of June, 1963,

ORDINANCE NO. N.S.- 29

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2-251 OF TITLE 2, CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE 4 OF THE ORDINANCE CODE OF STANISLAUS COUNTY

THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF STANISLAUS DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 2-251 of Title 2, Chapter 2, Article 4 of the Ordinance Code of Stanislaus County is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 2-251. The Board of Supervisors of Stanislaus County, California, does hereby make the provisions of Section 31681.51 of the Government Code of California and Section 31739.31 of the Government Code of California as amended by Chapter 671 of the Statutes of 1967 applicable in Stanislaus County as a part of the County Employees Retirement Law of 1937, being Title 3, Division 4, Part 3 of the Government Code of California which is now in full force and effect in Stanislaus County."

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force thirty (30) days from and after the date of its passage, it shall be published once, with the names of the members voting for and against the same, in The Modesto Bee, a newspaper published in said County of Stanislaus, State of California.


